Class of 2022 First Destination Survey

Career Works, in partnership with Institutional Research, Assessment, and Planning (IRAP), and The Office of Advancement & Alumni Relations, surveyed 199 graduates from the Class of 2022, to determine their first destinations. The survey methodology aligns with the standards and protocols approved by the National Association for Colleges & Employers, the governing organization for career development professionals. The project connected with 146 respondents, representing a 73.37% response rate.

Overall, 86.99%% of graduates were engaged in full-time work, education, or service. Below, please find a summary of relevant data.
